*An Ordinance to amend the "Scab Ordinance 1866."*

WHEREAS it is necessary to amend the "Scab Act 1866" B.F. Preamble. it therefore enacted by the Superintendent of the Province of Taranaki with the advice and consent of the Provincial Council thereof as follows :—

1. The short title of this Ordinance shall be the "Scab Short Title. Ordinance 1866 Amendment Ordinance 1875."

2. From and after the passing of this Ordinance all sheep introduced into the Province by sea upon production of a certificate from the inspector of the district from whence the sheep shall have been last brought by sea that such sheep were
