AN ORDINANCE to further amend the "Sale of Liquors Ordinance 1866," Title.

WHEREAS it is provided by the 17th clause of the recited Ordinance that every certificate authorising the issue of General Licenses shall be void unless the sum to be paid for such license be paid within twenty-one days after the granting of such certificate. And whereas it is expedient to amend the recited clause. BE it therefore enacted by the Superintendent of the Province of Taranaki with the advice and consent of the Provincial Council thereof as follows:—

1. The license fees payable on all certificates issued under the recited Ordinance for General Licenses for the Town of New Plymouth shall henceforth be payable by four equal instalments.

2. It shall be lawful for the Provincial Treasurer to issue licenses to the persons named in the list of certificates supplied to him within twenty-one days after the granting of such
