AN ORDINANCE TO VEST THE REVENUE ARISING OUT OF A PORTION OF THE EDUCATIONAL RESERVES IN THE TOWN BOARD OF NEW PLYMOUTH,

An Ordinance to vest the Revenue arising out of a portion of the Title. Educational Reserves in the Town Board of New Phymouth.

WHEREAS by Deed of Grant bearing date the twentieth day of Preamble. August 1858 the unalienated lands within the Town of New Plymouth FitzRoy District are vested in the Superintendent of the Province of Taranaki under the provisions of "The Public Reserves Act 1854" upon trust as an endowment for Public Schools and for general Educational purposes And whereas it is deemed expedient that the revenue derived from a portion of the said lands should be vested in the Town Board of New Plymouth BE it therefore enacted by the Superintendent of the Province of Taranaki with the advice and consent of the Provincial Council thereof as follows:—



### TOWN BOARD OF NEW PLYMOUTH ENDOWMENT ORDINANCE.

Lands described

1. The lands described in the Schedule heroto and comprised in Schedule but in the said recited Deed of Grant shall henceforth be held by the for the Town Superintendent of the Province of Taranaki upon trust as an Bloard of New endowment to the Town Board of New Plymouth for the purpose of improving the streets of the said town.

Power to Superintendent to let said land
intendent to let for any term not exceeding twenty-one years on such conditions
as may be agreed upon as to rent and improvements and as to
the right of the public to use the said land at stated periods for
cricketing and horse racing.

Appropriation of rents.

3. All reuts arising from the said lands shall be from time to time paid and accounted for to the Treasurer of the said Town Board and shall be appropriated to the purposes aforesaid subject to the provisions of this Ordinance and of any other Ordinance of the Superintendent and Provincial Council duly passed in that behalf.

Short Title.

5. The Short Title of this Ordinance shall be the "Town Board of New Plymouth Endowment Ordinance 1867."
