An ORDINANCE to prohibit the use of Shingles and other in flammable materials for Roofing Buildings within certain Districts. Title.

WHEREAS it is expedient to make provision for preventing the use of inflammable materials for roofing Buildings in Towns or the central portions of Towns. BE it therefore enacted by the Superintendent of the Province of Taranaki with the advice and consent of the Provincial Council thereof as follows :— Preamble.

1. It shall be lawful for the Superintendent with the advice of the Provincial Council expressed by a resolution thereof from time to time by proclamation in the Government Gazette of the Province to declare the provisions hereinafter contained to be in force in any Town or part of a Town within the Province of Taranaki the boundaries whereof respectively shall be defined by such proclamation. In such Town &c. no roof to be covered with inflammable materials.

2. If any person shall use or cause to be used any material for re-covering the roof of any old Building or covering the roof of a newly erected Building in any Town or part of a Town in which the provisions of this Ordinance have previously been declared to be in force other than metal slate earthen tiles or other uninflamable material he shall forfeit and pay for every such offence the sum of Twenty Pounds recoverable in a summary way.

What to constitute a fresh offence.

3. If any person having been convicted one or more times under this Ordinance shall neglect for the space of one calendar month to cover the roof in respect of which he was so convicted with metal slate earthen tiles or other uninflamable substance he shall be deemed to have committed a fresh offence and shall be liable on conviction to the same penalty as for the first offence.

Information to be laid by Chief Officer of Police or other authorised person.

4. All informations under this Ordinance shall be laid either by the Chief Officer of Police for the Town or District in which the offence is committed or by some other person duly authorised in that behalf by the Superintendent.

Ordinance to come into operation on 1st day of July 1868.

5. This Ordinance shall come into operation on the 1st day of July 1868.

Short Title.

6. The short Title of this Ordinance shall be the "Town Buildings Roofing Ordinance 1867."
