AN ACT to appropriate the Revenue of the Province of Wellington for a Term commencing on the 1st day of April, 1871, and ending on the 31st day of May, 1871.

[29th June, 1871.]

BE IT ENACTED by the Superintendent of the Province of Wellington with the advice and consent of the Provincial Council thereof :

1. The Short Title of this Act shall be the "Ad Interim Appropriation Act 1871."

1. That out of the Revenue of the said Province there may be issued and applied for defraying the charge of the Government thereof for the term commencing the 1st day of April 1871 and ending the 31st day of May 1871 the sum of £3957 1s. 8d. to be appropriated to the following purposes—
