E IT ENACTED by the Superintendent of the Province of Wellington, with the advice and consent of the Provincial Council thereof:-

1. The Treasurer of the Province shall issue from time to time any sum or sums of money for the purposes hereinbefore mentioned, not exceeding in the whole such sums respectively specified and provided as referred to such persons, and in such portions as the Superintendent of the Province shall by any Warrant issued by him from time to time direct, and such Treasurer shall in his accounts be allowed credit for all sums paid by him in pursuance of such Warrants, and the receipts of the persons to whom such sums shall have been paid.

Council do not should be summoned to meet in the year 1857 earlier than in the month ruary, power to of February, and some time may consequently elapse before the Revenue dent to author of the Province can be appropriated for the year commencing 1st January, rise a propor. tionate expenditure for a 1857, the Superintendent of the Province may, until such Appropriation shall take place, authorise the application and expenditure of such sums of money as may be proportionate to the sums hereby appropriated on the same services for the period of three months terminating on the 31st day of March, 1857, unless the said Council shall have made other provision for the same in the meantime.

And Whereas the actual expenditure for the Civil Government and med for the 1st public works and undertakings has exceeded the sums authorized by the Appropriation Act for the twelve months, from the 1st January, 1855, to the 31st December. 1855, by the sum of seven hundred and sixty-seven pounds six shillings and eight pence, according to the items enumerated in the schedule hereunto annexed. AND WHEREAS the said expenditure was reasonable and necessary, therefore the Superintendent is hereby indemnified for the issue of his Warrants for the said amount of £767 6s. 8d.
