AN ACT to amend "An Act to establish an Executive Government for the Province of Wellington Session I. No. 1" and "An Act to Amend the Executive Government Act Session I. No. 1 so as to authorise the offices of Treasurer and Secretary to be held by one person Session VI. No. 2."

WHEREAS it is expedient to amend an Act of the Superintendent and Provincial Council of Wellington Session I. No. 1 intituled "An Act to establish an Executive Government for the Province of Wellington" and an Act of the Superintendent and Provincial Council of Wellington Session VI. No. 2 intituled "An Act to Amend the Executive Government Act Session I. No. 1 so as to authorise the offices of Treasurer and Secretary to be held by one person."

BE IT ENACTED by the Superintendent of the Province of Wellington with the advice and consent of the Provincial Council thereof as follows—

1. The Short Title of this Act shall be "The Executive Government Act Amendment Act 1871."
2. Clause 5 of the above recited Act Session I. No. 1 is hereby repealed.
3. Clauses 12 14 15 and 18 of the above recited Act Session I. No. 1 shall be read as if the word "Solicitor" had been omitted therefrom.
4. Clause 3 of the above recited Act Session VI. No. 2 shall be read as if the word "Solicitor" had been omitted therefrom.
5. That the Executive shall consist of not less than two members being members of the Provincial Council.
