AN ACT to prohibit Burials in a certain Title.
block of Land in the Township of
Foxton.

[30th June, 1871.]

BE IT ENACTED by the Superintendent of the Province of Wellington preamble.
by and with the advice and consent of the Provincial Council thereof as
follows—

1. The Short Title of this Act shall be "The Foxton Burials Short Title.
Prevention Act 1871."

2. After the passing of this Act it shall not be lawful to bury any Burials not to be
made.
body in the piece of land described in the Schedule to this Act.

3. Every person who after the passing of this Act shall bury any Penalty in case of
infringement.
body or in any wise act or assist in the burial of any body in the piece of
land the boundaries whereof are described in the Schedule to this Act shall
be guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction in a summary way before
two Magistrates shall be liable to a fine of not exceeding ten pounds
or imprisonment for any term not exceeding three calendar months or to
both fine and imprisonment at the discretion of the Court.

4. It shall be the duty of the Provincial Secretary immediately after Notice to be given.
the passing of this Act to give notice thereof in the Provincial Government
Gazette and to cause a copy of such notice to be posted in some conspicuous
place in the township of Foxton.

SCHEDULE.

All that piece or parcel of land contained in section No. 97 on the plan of the
township of Foxton, containing by admeasurement one acre, more or less; bounded on
the North by section No. 96 470 links; towards the East by a public road 228 links;
towards the South by a public road 422 links; and towards the West by a public road
260 links.
