

THE WESTLAND FERRIES ORDINANCE, 1875.

An Ordinance to impose a Penalty on Persons using the Ferries title in the Province of Westland without paying the Ferryage and also upon the Ferryman for neglect of duty.

ANALYSIS.

Preamble.

WHEREAS no sufficient remedy exists to prevent persons from Preamble, making use of the ferries in the Province of Westland without paying the ferryage thereon.

BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED by the Superintendent of the Province of Westland by and with the advice and consent of the Provincial Council thereof as follows:—

- 1. This Ordinance shall be intituled and may be cited as "The short Title. Westland Ferries Ordinance 1875."
- 2. If any person shall make use of any ferry in the Province of Penalty for Westland and shall neglect or refuse to pay the ferryage lawfully using ferry payable in respect of the use of such ferry he shall forfeit and paying. for every such offence any sum not exceeding five pounds.

3. Any ferryman who shall take or demand more ferryage than he is authorised by law to charge or who shall refuse to give his name to any person demanding the same after having paid the ferryage or who shall unnecessarily detain or wilfully obstruct or hinder any passenger from using the ferry shall for every such offence forfeit and pay any sum not exceeding five pounds.

Misdemeanors

4. If any traveller passenger or other person shall unnecessarily of passengers or wilfully obstruct or hinder any ferryman whilst engaged in the discharge of his duty as a ferryman such traveller passenger or other person shall for every such offence forfeit and pay any sum not exceeding five pounds.

5. All penalties imposed under this Ordinance shall be recoverable Penalties how recoverable in a summary way.
