

NORTHERN INDUSTRIAL DISTRICT **MARINE-ENGINE DRIVERS.**—AMENDMENT OF AWARD

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1925, and the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations 1942; and in the matter of the Northern Industrial District Marine-engine Drivers' award, dated the 5th day of December, 1938, and recorded in 38 Book of Awards 3581.

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it by the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations 1942, and of every other power in that behalf thereunto enabling it, this Court, for the purpose of giving effect to the pronouncement made by it on the 15th day of August, 1947, doth hereby order as follows:—

1. That the said award (as amended by order of the Court dated the 27th day of August, 1945) shall be further amended in the manner following:—

(1) By deleting subclause (a) of clause 3 (Wages) of Part I, and substituting therefor, the following subclause:—

“(a) The minimum rate of pay shall be £32 1s. 3d. per calendar month.”

(2) By deleting clause 10 of Part II, and substituting therefor the following clause:—

“Wages

“10. The minimum rate of pay shall be £7 4s. per week.”

(3) By deleting clause 15 of Part III, and substituting therefor the following clause:—

“Wages

“15. The minimum rates of pay per calendar month shall be as follows:—

(4) By deleting clause 24 of Part IV, and substituting therefor the following clause:—

“ *Wages*

“ 24. The minimum wage shall be £7 2s. 9d. per week.”

(5) By deleting clause 31 of Part V, and substituting therefor the following clause:—

“ *Wages*

“ 31. The minimum rate of pay shall be £7 14s. 6d. per week.”

(6) By inserting, after clause 31 of Part V (*Wages*), the following new clause:—

Exclusion from Operation of General Orders

“ 31A. The rates of remuneration provided for in this award shall *not* be subject to the provisions of the two general orders of the Court made under the Rates of Wages Emergency Regulations 1940, and dated the 9th August, 1940, and the 31st March, 1942, respectively.”

2. That this order shall come into force on the 1st day of October, 1947.
