## CHRISTCHURCH CITY COUNCIL OFFICERS (OTHER THAN CLERICAL).—AMENDMENT OF INDUSTRIAL AGREEMENT

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1925, and the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations 1942; and in the matter of the Christchurch City Council Officers' (other than Clerical) industrial agreement, made on the 4th day of August, 1944, and recorded in 44 Book of Awards 769.

In pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it by the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations 1942, and of every other power in that behalf thereunto enabling it, this Court, for the purpose of giving effect to the pronouncement made by it on the 15th day of August, 1947, doth hereby order as follows:—

1. That the said industrial agreement (as amended by orders of the Court dated the 15th day of April, 1946, and

the 19th day of December, 1946) shall be further amended in the manner following:—

(1) By deleting clause 5, and substituting therefor the following clause;—

## "Remuneration or Salaries

- "5. (a) The increments shown in the various sections shall be considered as annual increments, and shall be paid according to years of service in each particular section.
- "(b) All increases in salary shall be paid after twelve months' service with the Council dating from the commencement of such service.

- (3) By deleting paragraph (c) of subclause (ii) of clause 14 (Traffic Department: Special Clauses for Traffic Inspectors), and substituting therefor the following paragraph:—
  - "(c) Assistant Chief: £440 12s. 6d.-£493 2s. 6d. per annum, by £10 annual increments.
    - "Subject to the provisions of clause 12, when an Inspector is required to supervise other Inspectors he shall be classified as Senior Patrol Inspector and shall receive the salary provided as from the commencement of such service.
    - "Senior Patrol Inspectors: £440 12s. 6d. per annum.

"Traffic Inspectors:—

- "On appointment: £377 12s. 6d. per annum.
- "Second year: £388 2s. 6d. per annum.
- "Third year: £398 12s. 6d. per annum.
- "Fourth year: £409 2s. 6d. per annum.
- "Fifth year and thereafter: £419 12s. 6d. per annum."
- 2. That this order shall come into force on the 1st day of October, 1947.
