

NORTHERN INDUSTRIAL DISTRICT PIANO TUNERS AND REPAIRERS—
AMENDMENT OF AWARD

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1925, and the Economic Stabilization Regulations 1952; and in the matter of the Northern Industrial District Piano Tuners and Repairers award, dated the 14th day of November 1950, and recorded in 50 Book of Awards 1997.

In pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it by Regulation 9 (1) of the Economic Stabilization Regulations 1952, and upon application made in that behalf by the parties to the above-mentioned award, this Court, for the purpose of giving effect to the pronouncement made by it on the 12th day of July 1952, doth hereby order as follows:—

1. That the said award shall be amended in the manner following:—

(1) By deleting subclause (a) of clause 3 (Wages) and substituting the following subclause:—

“(a) The minimum wage for piano tuners, player-piano, or organ tuners and/or repairers, assemblers and fitters of pianos and/or organ mechanism shall be £9 17s. 4d. per week.”

(2) By inserting after clause 4 the following new clause: —

“ *Exclusion from Operation of General Order*

“ 4A. The rates of remuneration provided for in this award shall *not* be subject to the provisions of the general order of the Court, dated the 30th January 1951, and made under the Economic Stabilization Regulations 1950.”

(3) By deleting from clause 9 (Meal-money) the figure and symbol “ 3s.” and substituting the figures and symbols “ 3s. 6d.”

2. That this order shall be deemed to have come into force on the 1st day of September 1952.
