NORTH CANTERBURY HOSPITAL BOARD MALE NURSES—AGREEMENT UNDER LABOUR DISPUTES INVESTIGATION ACT, 1913

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand, Canterbury Industrial District.— In the matter of the Economic Stabilization Regulations 1952; and in the matter of the agreement, made on the 2nd of September 1952, between the North Canterbury Hospital Board and the Canterbury Branch, N.Z. Registered Male Nurses' Society.

WHEREAS by the Economic Stabilization Regulations 1952 it is provided that no agreement made in pursuance of the Labour Disputes Investigation Act, 1913, shall come into force until it is filed under section 8 of the said Act: And whereas it is provided further that no such agreement shall be accepted by a Clerk of Awards for filing as aforesaid unless it has been approved by the Court for the purposes of the said regulations: And whereas application has been made for approval of the agreement made on the 2nd day of September 1952, between the North Canterbury Hospital Board, of the one part, and the Canterbury Branch, N.Z. Registered Male Nurses' Society, of the other part: Now therefore, the Court, having had regard to and having taken into consideration the matters and things as required by the said regulations.

NORTH CANTERBURY HOSPITAL BOARD MALE NURSES-AGREEMENT UNDER THE LABOUR DISPUTES INVESTIGATION ACT, 1913

This agreement is made this 2nd day of September, 1952 pursuant to the provisions of the Labour Disputes Investigation Act, 1913, between the North Canterbury Hospital Board (hereinafter referred to as "the employer ") and the undermentioned society (hereinafter called "the workers"). The employer and the workers hereby agree as follows:—

1. The terms and conditions of employment between the employer and the workers shall, *mutatis mutandis* be the terms and conditions set out in the Hospital Employment (Male Nurses) Regulations 1952, Serial Number 1952/91.

2. *Disputes.*—If any dispute shall arise in connection with the operation of this agreement, the question in dispute shall be referred to a Committee consisting of two representatives of the employer and two representatives of the workers for settlement.

3. Scope of Agreement.—This agreement shall apply only to the parties named herein.

4. Term of Agreement.—This agreement shall come into force on the day of the date hereof, and shall continue in force until the 31st day of July, 1954.
