In the matter of the New Zealand Radio Engineering and Servicing Industries Apprenticeship Order, dated the 23rd day of December, 1952, and recorded in 52 Book of Awards 2513.

By a resolution dated the 24th March, 1953, the New Zealand Radio Manufacturing and Servicing Apprenticeship Committee approved for the purposes of clause 8 (*b*) of the above-mentioned order, the following subjects of the School Certificate Examination: English, and one of the following—mathematics, chemistry, electricity and magnetism, general science, heat light and sound, applied mechanics, engineering shopwork and practice, technical drawing, technical electricity.

NEW ZEALAND **RADIO ENGINEERING AND SERVICING INDUSTRIES—**  
AMENDMENT OF APPRENTICESHIP ORDER

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand.—In the matter of the Apprentices Act, 1948; and in the matter of the New Zealand Radio Engineering and Servicing Industries apprenticeship order, dated the 23rd day of December 1952, and recorded in 52 Book of Awards 2513.

WHEREAS by section 13 (2) of the Apprentices Act, 1948, the Court is empowered to amend any apprenticeship order: And whereas application has been made to the Court by the New Zealand Radio Engineering and Servicing Apprenticeship Committee for amendment of the New Zealand Radio Engineering and Servicing Industries Apprenticeship Order, dated the 23rd day of December 1952: And whereas the Court has considered the recommendations made to it by the said Committee: Now, therefore, the Court, in pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it by the said Act, doth hereby order as follows:—

1. That the said apprenticeship order shall be amended by adding to clause 11 (Wages) the following subclause:—

“(d) In the case of any contract that is in force on the 1st day of April 1953, the rate of wages payable to the apprentice shall be determined in accordance with the terms of the apprenticeship order (and any amendments thereof) applicable thereto immediately before the 1st day of April 1953.”

2. That this order shall operate and take effect as from the 1st day of April 1953.
