## NORTH ISLAND CHEMICAL FERTILISER WORKERS— VARIATION OF AGREEMENT UNDER THE LABOUR DISPUTES **INVESTIGATION ACT 1913**

It is hereby agreed between the parties that the agreement dated the 30th day of September 1970, shall be varied in the manner following:-

1. By increasing the rates of wages prescribed by Clause 10 (a), Wages, by 4 cents per hour in accordance with the decision of the Chairman of a Disputes Committee dated 3 May 1971, so that the rates of wages become:
