PROCLAMATION.

By His Excellency ROBERT FITZROY,
Esquire, Captain in Her Majesty's Royal
Navy, and Governor and Commander-inChief in and over Her Majesty's Colony
of New Zealand and its Dependencies,
and Vice Admiral of the same, &c.,
&c., &c.

extend the Blockade of the Bay of Islands—proclaimed on the seventeenth day of April last—along the whole line of Coast from Wangarei to Wangaroa, including both these places—in order to prevent intercourse with the Natives who are in arms against Her Majesty—and, as a measure of precaution for the safety of vessels which might be surprised:—

I, the Governor, do hereby proclaim and declare, that no Merchant vessel will be allowed to remain in, or have any intercourse with the above-mentioned places during the continuance of such Blockade.

Given under my Hand, and issued under the Public Seal of the Colony, at Government House, (L. S.) Auckland, this nineteenth day of May, in the year of Our Lord One thousand eight hundred and forty-five.
