PROCLAMATION.

By His Excellency GEORGE GREY, Esquire, Lieutenant-Governor and Commander-in-Chief in and over Her Majesty's Colony of New Zealand, and its Dependencies, and Vice-Admiral of the same, &c., &c., &c.

HEREAS, the under-mentioned Ordinance enacted by the Lieutenant-Governor of New Zealand, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, was passed in the 9th year of the Reign of Her Majesty Queen Victoria, viz.—

No. 1. An Ordinance to empower the Governor of New Zealand to regulate the Importation and Sale of Arms, Gunpowder, and other Warlike Stores, (13th December, 1845.)

Which Ordinance having been by the Right Honorable W. E. Gladstone, one of Her Majesty's Principal Secretaries of State, laid before the Queen, Her Majesty has been pleased to confirm and allow the same.

Now, therefore, I, the Lieutenant-Governor, do hereby proclaim and make known to all whom it may concern, that Her Majesty has

been graciously pleased to confirm and allow the before-mentioned Ordinance.
