LIVERPOOL, Governor. A PROCLAMATION.

WHEREAS under the provisions of the Land Act, 1908, the lands enumerated in the first column of the Schedule hereto were temporarily reserved as endowments for educational purposes as specified in the second column of the said Schedule, upon the respective dates specified in the third column, and severally set opposite the respective descriptions of the said lands:

And whereas notices of such reservations were laid before both Houses of Parliament: And whereas the two Houses have passed resolutions, upon the dates specified in the fourth column, approving, in terms of the three-hundred-and-twenty-fourth section of the Land Act, 1908, of the lands being parliamently set aside as endowments for educational numbers.
