The total births in the four chief cities and their suburban boroughs amounted to 653, against 615 in December-an increase of 38. The deaths in January were 248-an increase of 15 as compared with last month. Of the total deaths, males contributed 119, females 129. Fifty of the deaths were of children under five years of age, being 2016 per cent. of the whole number; 44 of these were under one year of age.

There were 86 deaths of persons of 65 years and upwards in the four chief cities and their suburban boroughs, as against 72 in December. The following table shows the classification :--
