A PROCLAMATION.

WHEREAS by section seventy seven of the New Zealand State-guaranteed Advances Act, 1909, as amended by section twenty-two of the New Zealand Stateamended by section twenty-two of the New Zealand State-guaranteed Advances Amendment Act, 1910, it is, amongst other things, enacted that in no case shall any moneys be expended under the provisions of the said section seventy-seven in connection with any block of land unless that block is set apart for selection under that rection pursuant to Proclamation in that behalf:
