## RESOLUTION.

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it in that behalf by the Municipal Corporations Act, 1908, the Local Bodies' Loans Act, 1908, and their respective amendments, the Napier Borough Council hereby resolves as follows:—

"That, for the purpose of providing the interest, sinking fund, and other charges on a loan of £12,000, authorized to be raised by the said Napier Borough Council, under the above-mentioned Acts, for the following purpose—that is to say, the completion of the construction of drainage-works in and for the Borough of Napier now in progress, the said Napier Borough Council hereby makes and levies a special rate of one penny and one-twenty-fifth of a penny in the pound upon the rateable value, on the basis of the annual value, of all rateable property of the Borough of Napier, comprising the whole of the said borough; and that such special rate shall be an annual-recurring rate during the currency of such loan, and be payable yearly on the first day of August in each and every year during the currency of such loan, being a period of thirty-one years or thereabouts—that is to say, until the thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and forty-four, or until the loan is fully paid off.
