Referring to General Notice to Mariners, Victoria, dated 1st August, 1907, page 107, and to subsequent notices regarding alterations to Wilson's Promontory light, mariners and others are hereby notified that the new light will be exhibited on and from 1st May, 1913.

The characteristics of the light are as follows:—

White, dioptrie, group flashing, showing four flashes in quick succession every fifteen seconds—thus, flash \(\frac{1}{4}\) second, eclipse 2 seconds; flash \(\frac{1}{4}\) second, eclipse 3 seconds.

Power, 189,000 candles; visible in clear weather, 27 nautical miles; are of visiblity unaltered; height of focal plane above high water, 381 ft.

Upon the exhibition of the new light the temporary fixed light will be discontinued.
