MANGAWEKA TOWN BOARD.

Resolution.

IN pursuance and in exercise of the powers vested in it in that behalf by the Local Bodies' Loans Act, 1908, and its amendments, the Mangaweka Town Board hereby resolves as follows: That, for the purpose of providing interest, sinking fund, and other charges on a special loan of £900, authorized to be raised under the above-mentioned Acts, for the purpose of supplying electricity to the inhabitants of Mangaweka, and to light streets and public places, the Mangaweka Town Board hereby makes and levies a special rate of ½d. in the pound sterling to be levied upon the rateable valuation (on the basis of capital value) of the rateable property of the Town District of Mangaweka; and that such special rate shall be an annual-recurring rate during the currency of such loan, and be payable half-yearly on the 14th day of July in each and every year during the currency of such loan, being a period of forty years, or until the loan is fully paid off.

TAMAKI WEST ROAD BOARD.

Resolution making Special Rate.

IN pursuance and in exercise of the powers vested in it in that behalf by the Local Bodies' Loans Act, 1908, and its amendments, the Tamaki West Road Board hereby resolves as follows: That, for the purpose of providing interest, sinking fund, and other charges on a special loan of £10,000, authorized to be raised, under the above-mentioned Acts, for the purpose of erecting a reservoir for water-supply, and laying mains, and other necessary work and contingencies, and engineering charges in connection with obtaining a water service for the district, the Tamaki West Road Board hereby makes and levies a special rate of ½d. in the pound sterling to be levied upon the rateable valuations (on the basis of the capital value) of the rateable property of the Road District of Tamaki West; and that such special rate shall be an annually recurring rate during the currency of such loan, and be payable yearly on the 1st day of May in each and every year during the currency of such loan, being a period of thirty-six years and a half, or until the loan is fully paid off.

Notice of Result of Poll on Proposal to raise a Loan.
