PAPAKURA TOWN BOARD.

RESOLUTION.

AT the monthly meeting of the Papakura Town Board held on Monday, the 4th day of August, 1913, the following resolution was passed:—

That, in pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it in that behalf by the Local Bodies' Loans Act, 1908, the Papakura Town Board hereby resolves as follows: That, for the purpose of providing the interest and other charges on a loan of one hundred and twenty-five pounds sterling, authorized to be raised by the Papakura Town Board, under the above-mentioned Act, being an amount equal to ten per centum on the original loan of £1,250 raised by the said Town Board for road-improvement, the said Papakura Town Board hereby makes and levies a special rate of 1/50th of a penny in the pound upon the rateable value of all rateable property of the Papakura Town District; and that such special rate shall be an annual-recurring rate during the currency of such loan, and be payable on the first day of September in each and every year during the currency of such loan, being a period of thirty-six and a half years (36½ years), or until the loan is fully paid off.
