pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it in that behalf by the Local Bodies' Loans Act, 1908, and its amendments, the Stratford County Council hereby resolves

That, for the purpose of providing the interest and other charges on a loan of £300, authorized to be raised by the Stratford County Council, under the above-mentioned Act, for the purpose of defraying the cost of metalling the Makuri Road from the Douglas Road westward to the end of the existing metal, the said Stratford County Council hereby makes and levies a special rate of one halfpenny in the pound upon the rateable value of all rateable property of the Makuri (Huiroa) Road No. 3 Special-rating District, comprising Secupon the rateable value of all rateable property of the Makuri (Huiroa) Road No. 3 Special-rating District, comprising Sections 4, 5, 6, 7, 12, 13, 14, 23, 24, Block XII, Huiroa Survey District; Sections 1 to 7, inclusive, Block I, Sections 1 to 5, inclusive, Block II, Sections 1 to 6, inclusive, Block V, Huiroa Township; and part Section 3, containing 62½ acres, Block IX, Ngatimaru Survey District: and that such rate shall be an annual-recurring rate during the currency of such loan, and be payable yearly on the first day of February in each and every year during the currency of such loan, being a period of thirty-six and a half years, or until the loan is fully paid off.
