Land taken for the Purposes of a Road in Block IX, Tutaki Survey District.

A PROCLAMATION.

WHEREAS the land described in the Schedule hereto is required to be taken, under the Public Works Act, 1908, for a certain public work, to wit, for road purposes in Block IX, Tutaki Survey District:

And whereas an agreement has been entered into, in terms of section twenty-seven of the said Act, to take such land for the public work hereinafter set forth:

And whereas a plan has been prepared, and the Minister has recommended the Governor to issue a Proclamation taking the land as required by the said Act:

Now, therefore, I, Arthur William de Brito Savile, Earl of Liverpool, the Governor of the Dominion of New Zealand, in pursuance and exercise of the powers and authorities vested in me by the Public Works Act, 1908, and of every other power and authority in anywise enabling me in this behalf, and being satisfied of the sufficiency of the agreement hereinbefore referred to, do hereby proclaim and declare that the land described in the Schedule hereto is hereby taken for road purposes; and I also hereby declare that this Proclamation shall take effect on and after the fifteenth day of September, one thousand nine hundred and thirteen.

All in the Nelson Land District; as the same are more particularly delineated on the plan marked and coloured as above mentioned, and deposited in the office of the Minister of Public Works, at Wellington, in the Wellington Provincial District.

Given under the hand of His Excellency the Right Honourable Arthur William de Brito Savile, Earl of Liverpool, Knight Commander of the Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George, Member of the Royal Victorian Order, Governor and Commander-in-Chief in and over His Majesty's Dominion of New Zealand and its Dependencies; and issued under the Seal of the said Dominion, at the Government House, at Wellington, this twenty-seventh day of August, in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and thirteen.

EASTBOURNE BOROUGH COUNCIL.

RESOLUTION MAKING SPECIAL RATE.

THE following resolution was duly passed at a special meeting of the Council held on 1st September, 1913:—
“That, in pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it in that behalf by the Municipal Corporations Act, 1908, and the Local Bodies' Loans Act, 1908, and their amending Acts, the Eastbourne Borough Council hereby resolves that, for the purpose of providing security for principal and interest of the No. 3 Loan of £15,000, authorized to be raised under the above-mentioned Acts, for the purpose of purchasing the ferry steamers “Duchess” and “Cobar,” and for establishing a municipal ferry service, a rate of 2½d. in the pound on the unimproved value of all rateable property in the Borough of Eastbourne is hereby made as an annual-recurring rate for a period of twenty-one years, or during the currency of the loan; and such special rate shall be payable half-yearly on the 1st day of March and 1st day of September in each and every year during the currency of such loan.”
