

Notice of Meeting of Owners under Part XVIII of the Native Land Act, 1909.

REGULATION No. 48.

THE Maori Land Board for the Tairāwhiti Maori Land District hereby notifies that a meeting of the owners of Tuawhātu No. 1A 2 Block will be held, in pursuance of Part XVIII of the Native Land Act, 1909, at Whangara on Friday, the 10th day of October, 1913, at 11 o'clock in the forenoon, for the purpose of considering the following proposed resolution:—

“That a sale of the said land, or any part thereof, to Karepa Kautuku shall be agreed to; or, in the alternative, that a lease of the said land be granted to Karepa Kautuku, of Tolaga Bay, Native, for a term of twenty-one years at a rental equivalent to 5 per centum on the present Government valuation thereof, with a right to a renewal for a further term of twenty-one years at a rental equivalent to 5 per centum on the then Government valuation (unimproved) thereof.”
