WHEREAS by section two of the Mining Amendment Act, 1911, it is provided that the Governor, by Order in Council, may from time to time declare that any of the provisions of the Mining Act, 1908, shall apply to prospecting and mining for and the storage of petroleum and other mineral oils and of natural gas, and also define the district within which any such Order in Council shall take effect: And whereas by section seventy-five of the Reserves and other Lands Disposal and Public Bodies Empowering Act, 1912, it is further provided that any public reserve, endowment, or Native reserve within the meaning of reserve, endowment, or Native reserve within the meaning of the Mining Act, 1908, whether or not the same is situated within a mining district, may be included in any district as so defined:
