A PROCLAMATION.

WHEREAS the land described in the Schedule hereto is required to be taken, under the Public Works Act, 1908—to wit, for the purposes of waterworks in Block XVI, Christchurch Survey District:

And whereas the Lyttelton Borough Council has laid before the Governor a memorial, accompanied by a map in duplicate, and also the statutory declaration, as required by the said Act:

Now, therefore, I, Arthur William de Brito Savile, Earl of Liverpool, the Governor of the Dominion of New Zealand, in pursuance and exercise of the powers and authorities vested in me by the Public Works Act, 1908, and the Municipal Corporations Act, 1908, and of every other power and authority in anywise enabling me in this behalf, do hereby proclaim and declare that the land described in the Schedule hereto is hereby taken for the purposes of the said waterworks as from the date hereinafter specified, and shall vest in the Mayor, Councillors, and Burgesses of the Borough of Lyttelton; and I do hereby direct that this Proclamation shall take effect on and after the fifteenth day of November, one thousand nine hundred and thirteen.
