In pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it in that behalf by the Local Bodies' Loans Act, 1908, and by the New Zealand State-guaranteed Advances Act, 1909, and the amendments thereof, the Waikohu County Council hereby resolves as follows: That, for the purpose of providing the interest and sinking fund on a loan of £400, authorized to be raised by the Waikohu County Council, under the above-mentioned Acts, for erecting a bridge over the Mangatu River, the said Waikohu County Council hereby makes and levies a special rate of one-ninth of a penny in the pound upon the rateable value of all rateable property of the Mangamaia No. 4 Special-rating Area as described in the Schedule hereto; and that such rate shall be an annual-recurring rate during the currency of such loan, and be payable yearly on the first day of July in each and every year during the currency of such loan, being a period of thirty-six and a half years (36½), or until the loan is fully paid off. It is proposed to pay the cost of raising the loan out of loan-moneys.
