A PROCLAMATION.

WHEREAS, under the provisions in that behalf of section one hundred and eighty-eight of the Public Works Act, 1908, the middle-line of portion of the Stratford-Kawakawa Railway from 12 m. 7 ch. on the old trial line, P.W.D. 30654 (5 m. 76 ch. on present line, P.W.D. 30725), to 17 m. (P.W.D. 30480) were defined by Proclamations dated the thirteenth day of December, one thousand nine hundred and eleven, and the thirteenth day of October, one thousand nine hundred and eleven, respectively, and published in the New Zealand Gazette Nos. 101 and 82, of the fourteenth day of December, one thousand nine hundred and eleven, and the nineteenth day of October, one thousand nine hundred and eleven, respectively: And whereas it has been found necessary in the construction of such railway to alter such line in manner hereinafter appearing:
