A PROCLAMATION.

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers conferred by section eleven of the Land Act, 1908, I, Arthur William de Brito Savile, Earl of Liverpool, the Governor of the Dominion of New Zealand, do hereby, with the consents of the lessees, and mortgagees of the lands mentioned in the First Schedule hereto, and of the Cook County Council, being the local authority in whose district the said lands are situated, proclaim as roads the lands described in the First Schedule hereto; and also do hereby, with the like consents as aforesaid, proclaim as closed the road described in the Second Schedule hereto, which is not required by reason of the roads described in the First Schedule hereto.
