Every brewer desirous of removing beer to a bottling store by means of a pipe or other conduit under section 8 of the Beer Duty Amendment Act, 1913, shall apply to the Collector for permission to do so. 32. He shall at the same time submit a plan of such part of the barrent state of stores and for which it

35. If any person fails, refuses, or neglects to do anything required by these regulations, or wilfully does anything prohibited by these regulations, every such person so offending shall be liable to a penalty not exceeding £50.
