

That, for the purpose of providing the interest and other charges on a supplementary loan of seven hundred pounds (£700), authorized to be raised by the Te Kuiti Borough Council, under the above-mentioned Acts, for completion of a scheme of electric lighting in the Borough of Te Kuiti, the said Te Kuiti Borough Council hereby makes and levies a special rate of one thirty-second (1/32nd) of a penny in the pound upon the rateable value of all rateable property in the Borough of Te Kuiti, comprising the boundaries of the said borough as defined in the *New Zealand Gazette* of the 7th day of April, 1910; and that such special rate shall be an annual-recurring rate during the currency of such loan, and be payable half-yearly in each and every year during the currency of such loan, being a period of thirty-five years, or until the loan is fully paid off.
