The first list (I) contains the names of the successful candidates for Classes A, B, C, and D. Teachers' certificates will be issued to such of these as have produced satisfactory evidence of age and good character, and have passed the special medical examination required, and have fulfilled the recessary conditions as to length of service and efficiency in teaching. The list does not include the names of those who qualified for a certificate as training-college students independently of this examination.

The second list (II) gives the names of those who have passed in two or more subjects for Class C, but have yet to

complete the examination.

The third list (III) contains the names of those who obtained "partial passes" in the Class D Examination or partial success towards the first section thereof.

In the fourth list (IV) are given the names of the candidates whose work has been deemed worthy of "special mention."

The next examination will take place in January, 1915, beginning on or about the 5th day of the month. Notice must be sent to the Inspector-General of Schools, so as to reach him not later than the 15th October. Candidates who have yet to complete the examination must observe this have yet to complete the examination must observe this rule equally with other candidates, and must not expect to any further information of the date at which the notices become due.

Certificated teachers that have gained promotion at this examination may send their certificates to the Department for endorsement
