WHEREAS by section forty of the Public Reserves and Domains Act, 1908 (hereinafter termed "the said Act"), it is enacted that the Governor may from time to time, with respect to any public domain, appoint such persons (not exceeding nine) as he thinks fit to be a Domain Board having, subject to Part II of the said Act, control of such domain :

And whereas by an Order in Council made on the eighth day of February, one thousand nine hundred and four, and published in the *New Zealand Gazette* of the eleventh day of February, one thousand nine hundred and four, certain powers were delegated to the Pahautanui Domain Board for a period of ten years :

And whereas the period for which the said Board was appointed expired on the seventh day of February, one thousand nine hundred and fourteen :

And whereas it appears expedient to again appoint a Domain Board to control the domain :
