List I contains the names of candidates that have passed the scholarship examination, arranged in groups according to the several education districts. In each group the names are given in order of merit, with the total marks assigned to the candidates out of a possible total of 800 marks. On the production of such further evidence of eligibility as may be required, and on compliance with such further conditions of examination as may be imposed by the regulations of the several districts, scholarships will be awarded by the Education Boards to candidates on this list within the limit of the number of scholarships in each case available.
