

Domain Board appointed to have Control of the Gore Domain.

ORDER IN COUNCIL.

At the Government Buildings, at Wellington, this twenty-seventh day of March, 1914.

Present :

THE HONOURABLE W. FRASER PRESIDING IN COUNCIL.

WHEREAS by section forty-seven of the Public Reserves and Domains Act, 1908 (hereinafter termed "the said Act"), it is enacted that the Governor may from time to time, by Order in Council gazetted, appoint any local authority to be the Domain Board having, subject to the said Act, control of any public domain :

And whereas by an Order in Council made on the thirty-first day of March, one thousand nine hundred and four, and published in the *New Zealand Gazette* of the seventh day of April, one thousand nine hundred and four, powers were delegated to the Gore Domain Board in respect of the Gore Domain for a period of ten years :

And whereas the period for which the said Board was appointed expires on the thirtieth day of March, one thousand nine hundred and fourteen :

And whereas it appears expedient to again appoint a Domain Board to control the said domain :

Now, therefore, His Excellency the Governor of the Dominion of New Zealand, in exercise of the powers conferred by the said Act, and acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council of the said Dominion, doth hereby appoint

THE GORE BOROUGH COUNCIL

to be the Gore Domain Board, as from the thirty-first day of March, one thousand nine hundred and fourteen, having the control of the land described in the Schedule hereto for the purposes of and subject to the provisions of Part II of the said Act; and doth hereby appoint Monday, the twentieth day of April, one thousand nine hundred and fourteen, at half past seven o'clock p.m., as the time when, and the Borough Council Chambers, Mersey Street, Gore, as the place where, the first meeting of the Board shall be held.

Now, therefore, His Excellency the Governor of the Dominion of New Zealand, in exercise of the powers conferred by the said Act, and acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council of the said Dominion, doth hereby appoint
