

I chain in width running along the southern bank of Porarari River, for a distance of 1200 links; towards the south-east by the western boundary of Main North Road, for a distance of 350 and 715 links; and towards the west by a road reserve I chain in width running along the shore of Tasman Sea, for a distance of 1050 links: be all the aforesaid linkages more or less: as the same is delineated on the plan marked L. and S. 4701/15A, deposited in the Head Office, Department of Lands and Survey, at Wellington, and thereon coloured red. Bounded towards the north-east by Section 4, Block VI, Suburbs of Pipiroa Town, 1050.1 links; towards the south-east by Hauraki Street, 1,200 links; and towards the south-west by Moe Hau Street, 133.8 and 1509.8 links: be all the aforesaid linkages more or less; as the same is delineated on the plan marked L. and S. VI/6(1), deposited in the Head Office, Department of Lands and Survey, at Wellington, and thereon edged purple. (Auckland Plan 15879.)
