Defining River and Extended-river Limits for Whangape.

Marine Department,

Wellington, 4th May, 1914.

IN pursuance and exercise of the authority vested in me by section 189 of the Shipping and Seamen Act, 1908, I, Francis Marion Bates Fisher, Minister of Marine, do hereby define the limits within which restricted-limits steamships and ships propelled by gas, oil, fluid, electricity, or any mechanical power other than steam, and to which restricted-limits certificates are issued, may ply to be those set forth herein.

River Limits.—Inside the entrance of Whangape and Herekino Harbours.

Extended-river Limits.—Between Whangape and Herekino on the north, and between Whangape and Hokianga on the south.
