The total births in the four chief cities and their suburban boroughs amounted to 544, against 687 in March—a decrease of 93. The deaths in April were 256—an increase of 5 as compared with the previous month. Of the total deaths males contributed 131, females 125. Sixty-four of the deaths were of children under five years of age, being 25 per cent. of the whole number; 58 of these were under one year of age.

There were 74 deaths of persons of 65 years and upwards in the four chief cities and their suburban boroughs, as against 76 in March. The following table shows the classification:—
