WHEREAS by section one hundred and thirty-three (a) of the Public Works Act, 1908, it is enacted that a local authority shall not declare any county road or district road to be stopped until the consent thereto of the Governor by Order in Council gazetted is obtained :

And whereas the Hawke's Bay County Council has applied for such consent in respect of the road described in the Schedule hereto :

Now, therefore, in pursuance and exercise of the above-in-part-recited Act, and of all other powers in anywise enabling him in this behalf, His Excellency the Governor of the Dominion of New Zealand, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council of the said Dominion, doth hereby consent to the Hawke's Bay County Council stopping the road described in the Schedule hereto.

Road, in the Auckland Land District, Waitomo County, commencing at the eastern boundary of the Borough of Te Kuiti and proceeding thence in a north-easterly direction generally, adjoining or passing through Te Kuiti 2B 8, 2B 11, 2B 3, 2B 12B, 2B 6, 2B 2, and Section 6888, Rangitoto-Tuhua No. 64, Block IV, Otake Survey District, and terminating at the eastern boundary of the said Section 6888, Rangitoto-Tuhua No. 64, Block IV, Otake Survey District, at a point about 5 chains from the Mangarapa Stream, being a distance of three miles, more or less ; as the said portion of road is more particularly delineated on the plan marked P.W.D. 35779, deposited in the office of the Minister of Public Works at Wellington, in the Wellington Provincial District, and thereon coloured red.
