COPY OF RESOLUTION PASSED AT A SPECIAL MEETING HELD IN THE COUNCIL CHAMBERS, PAEROA, ON THURSDAY, THE 18th JUNE, 1914.

THAT, in pursuance of the powers vested in it in that behalf by the Local Bodies' Loans Act, 1908, and the amendments thereof and the regulations thereunder, the Chairman, Councillors, and Inhabitants of the County of Ohinemuri hereby resolve as follows:—

“That, for the purpose of providing the instalments in respect of the principal and interest and also other charges on a loan of £250, authorized to be raised by the Chairman, Councillors, and Inhabitants of the County of Ohinemuri, under the above-mentioned Act, and being an additional 10 per cent. on the amount of the original loan of £2,500 raised for the building of a bridge over the Waihou River at the Puke, the said Chairman, Councillors, and Inhabitants of the County of Ohinemuri hereby make and levy a special rate of one-eighth of a penny in the pound upon the rateable value of all the rateable property of the Waihou Bridge Special-rating Area; and that such special rate shall be an annual-recurring rate during the currency of the loan, and be payable on the 1st day of January in each and every year during the currency of such loan, being a period of 36½ years, or until the loan is fully paid off; and the cost of raising the loan shall be paid out of the loan.”—Carried.
