*Prize Courts.—Claim for Release of British and Neutral Cargo.*

IT is hereby notified that all persons having any interest in cargoes, other than enemy cargoes, laden on enemy ships captured as prizes, and requiring a release of such cargoes or portions of cargoes, should make inquiries in Wellington at the office of His Majesty's Attorney-General for New Zealand. The Attorney-General will require proof of ownership and particulars as to freight, whether paid or unpaid.
