MULCTS AND DEDUCTIONS.

2. (v.) Except in cases mentioned in 3 (b), a day's pay for the purpose of mulcts and deductions shall mean full active pay and allowances credited on the ledger, but not extra pay, ration, uniform, lodging, and kindred allowances.

MISCELLANEOUS ALLOWANCES (PETTY OFFICERS AND MEN).

2. (vi.) The following allowances will also be granted, being added to “active pay,” but no increase will be made in “deferred pay” :—
