*Authorizing Eden Terrace Road Board to exercise Powers conferred by Road Boards Amendment Act, 1914.*

*Exchange of Land in Annan Settlement, Canterbury Land District, for other Land.*

 A PROCLAMATION.

WHEREAS, pursuant to section two of the Road Boards Amendment Act, 1914 (hereinafter referred to as "the said Act"), the Eden Terrace Road Board has passed a resolution adopting the said Act:  
 Now, therefore, I, Arthur William de Brito Savile, Earl of Liverpool, the Governor of the Dominion of New Zealand, in pursuance and exercise of the power and authority vested in me by the said Act, do hereby proclaim and declare that the Eden Terrace Road Board is hereby authorized to exercise the powers conferred by the said Act.

Given under the hand of His Excellency the Right Honourable Arthur William de Brito Savile, Earl of Liverpool, Knight Grand Cross of the Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George, Member of the Royal Victorian Order, Governor and Commander-in-Chief in and over His Majesty's Dominion of New Zealand and its Dependencies; and issued under the Seal of the said Dominion, at the Government House at Wellington, this first day of January, in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and fifteen.

 A PROCLAMATION.

WHEREAS by section one hundred and twenty-nine of the Reserves and other Lands Disposal and Public Lands Empowering Act, 1913, it is enacted that on the transfer to His Majesty of the land described in the First Schedule hereto, free from incumbrance, the Governor shall by Proclamation declare that the land described in the Second Schedule hereto shall, as from the date of the said Proclamation, cease to be land comprised in a lease in perpetuity granted on the twenty-seventh day of November, one thousand nine hundred and three, and that the land described in the said First Schedule shall be deemed to be land comprised in the said lease:

And whereas the land described in the said First Schedule has been duly transferred to His Majesty free from incumbrance:

Now, therefore, I, Arthur William de Brito Savile, Earl of Liverpool, the Governor of the Dominion of New Zealand, do hereby proclaim and declare that from and after the date hereof the land described in the Second Schedule hereto shall cease to be land comprised in the lease in perpetuity granted on the twenty-seventh day of November, one thousand nine hundred and three, over Section No. 14, Blocks X, XI, and XIV, Waiau Survey District (Annan Settlement), Canterbury Land District, and that the land described in the First Schedule hereto shall from and after the date hereof be deemed to be land comprised in the said lease in perpetuity.
