And whereas by an Order in Council made on the seventh day of July, one thousand nine hundred and eight, and published in the *New Zealand Gazette* of the ninth day of July, one thousand nine hundred and eight, a Domain Board was appointed to control the Waharoa Domain:

And whereas the period for which the said Board was appointed expired on the sixth day of July, one thousand nine hundred and fifteen:

And whereas it appears expedient to again appoint a Domain Board to control the domain:
