The total births in the four chief cities and their suburban boroughs amounted to 575, against 600 in July—a decrease of 25. The deaths in August were 273—a decrease of 1 as compared with the previous month. Of the total deaths males contributed 135, females 138. Fifty-five of the deaths were of children under five years of age, being 20·15 per cent. of the whole number; 43 of these were under one year of age.

There were 88 deaths of persons of 65 years and upwards in the four chief cities and their suburban boroughs, as against 106 in July. The following table shows the classification:—
