The total births in the four chief cities and their suburban boroughs amounted to 563, against 575 in August—a decrease of 22. The deaths in September were 303—an increase of 30 as compared with the previous month. Of the total deaths males contributed 159, females 144. Sixty-eight of the deaths were of children under five years of age, being 22·44 per cent. of the whole number; 49 of these were under one year of age.

There were 96 deaths of persons of 65 years and upwards in the four chief cities and their suburban boroughs, as against 88 in August. The following table shows the classification:—
