Requiring all Males between Seventeen and Sixty Years of Age to register.

A PROCLAMATION.

IN pursuance and exercise of the power and authority vested in the Governor by the National Registration Act, 1915, I, Arthur William de Brito Savile, Earl of Liverpool, the Governor of the Dominion of New Zealand, do hereby require every male resident of New Zealand between the ages of seventeen and sixty, except members of the permanent paid military staff of the New Zealand Defence Department and members of the New Zealand Expeditionary Force reinforcements in camp undergoing training, to furnish to the Government Statistician at Wellington, within fourteen days from the coming into operation of this Proclamation, particulars in the prescribed form as to the matters specified in section four of the said Act.
